Lead based paint used in older homes can be a hazard to your children. In Linn County 2.8% of those children tested under the age of six have an elevated blood lead level. Lead poisoning is totally preventable.

City of Cedar Rapids and Linn County Public Health have been awarded a three year grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for Lead Hazard Control. All applicants must meet the HUD income guidelines AND house a child under age six to qualify for assistance, reside within the target area, and meet one of the grant priorities. Opportunities are available for investor owned properties where tenants meet the income guidelines. You may also qualify for additional rehabilitation assistance.


